THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR THIS WEEK . . .

Tuesday is the **Memorial of St Boniface** – a great English missionary. Born in c 675, he left England in 718 to preach the gospel in Germany, where he is still held in high esteem. Even in old age he did not rest but went on to evangelise Holland, where he was martyred, about 754.

Wednesday is the **Memorial of St Norbert** – among his many achievements for the Church in the early twelfth century, this bishop founded the Canons Regular of Premontre, the 'Premonstratensian Canons' or Norbertines. He lived from 1080 to 1134. A community of Norbertines serve the parishes of Our Lady Immaculate and Holy Name, Chelmsford.

Friday is the **Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus** – symbol of Christ's love for all.
