Monday is the **Memorial of St Barnabas** – one of the missionary companions of St Paul. He was a 'good man filled with the Holy Spirit and with faith'.

Wednesday is the **Memorial of St Anthony of Padua** - although he died before he was forty, in the year 1231, this Franciscan priest had proved himself to be an impressive preacher, a Scripture scholar, and a formidable defender of the Faith.
